ORDER:

In Government Order third read above, permission was accorded to the Chairman, Vellalar Educational Trust, Erode to apply to the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi to start 4 year B. Pharm course in the name and style as "Vellalar College of Pharmacy", Erode with an annual intake of 60 students from the academic year 2016-2017.

2. The Secretary, Vellalar Educational Trust, Thindal, Erode District has requested the Government to grant permission to enhance the seats in B.Pharmacy course from 60 to 100 at Vellalar College of Pharmacy, Thindal, Erode District from the academic year 2021-2022.

3. The Director of Medical Education was requested to conduct an inspection on the premises of the Trust for considering their request. Accordingly, the Director of Medical Education has constituted an inspection team to verify as to whether the proposed pharmacy college has fulfilled the conditions prescribed by the Government in the Government Orders first, second and fourth read above and as per the norms of the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi.

4. In his letter sixth read above, the Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal stating that the said institution has fulfilled the norms prescribed by the Government as well as by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi and recommended to grant permission to the Secretary, Vellalar Educational Trust, Thindal, Erode District to enhance the seats in B.Pharmacy course from 60 to 100 at Vellalar College of Pharmacy, Thindal, Erode District from the academic year 2021-2022.

5. The Government examined the case in detail in the light of the Inspection Report and the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and grant permission to the Secretary, Vellalar Educational Trust, Thindal, Erode District to enhance the seats in B.Pharmacy course from 60 to 100 seats (sixty to hundred) at "Vellalar College of Pharmacy", in S.F. Nos. 303/9, 10, 11, 12, 312/1B, 314/1A, 2, 3A, 6A1, Villarasampatti Village, Erode District- 638 012 from the academic year 2021-2022, subject to fulfill the following specific conditions along with other general conditions laid down in G.O (Ms) No.148, Health and Family Welfare (PME.2) Department, dated: 24.04.2018 as applicable to this proposal before admitting the students:-

- i. The Trust should obtain Clearance Certificate from the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board for the proposed pharmacy institution.
- ii. The Trust should obtain the recognition / affiliation from the Pharmacy Council of India and the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University respectively to the above pharmacy institution.

6. The Director of Medical Education is directed to take necessary further action accordingly.
